All about Saint Mildred!
Saint Mildred of Thanet (also known as Mildrith) was a 7th-century Anglo-Saxon princess who traded a life of royal ease for the service of Christ and His poor. Born to a ruling Mercian family, she traveled to France to receive a devout education at the Royal Ab-

bey of Chelles. Upon returning to England, she firmly rejected multiple marriage proposals to pursue her true calling.

She is often depicted with a small deer beside her. This is because the King of Kent gave her mother restitution for her murdered brothers by giving Domne Eafe (Mildred's mother) as much land on the Isle of Thanet that her pet deer could run around in a single day. The deer followed a divinely inspired path, roughly 10,000 acres of land for the new Catholic community.

She eventually entered the monastery of Minster-in-Thanet in Kent, which had been founded by her mother, St. Ermenburga. Mildred succeeded her mother to become the community's second abbess. As a leader, she was characterized by exceptional humility, gentleness, and a serene spirit. She is especially remembered for her incredible compassion and generosity toward widows, orphans, and the troubled.

Remembered by medieval writers as "The Fairest Lily of the English," she died following a prolonged and painful illness near the year 700.

Canonized in 1388, and her feast day is July 13th.



During the last three months, Mary fought courageously through serious health challenges, striving each day to recover and regain her strength. On Tuesday, June 23, 2026, she passed away peacefully, surrounded by her loving family.

Mary was a beautiful person and a truly remarkable human being. What I will remember most about her was her generosity, her spirit of service, and the way she always cared for others. She understood that life is not meant to be lived only for ourselves, but with and for one another. As pastor of Saint Mildred Catholic Church, I can say that our parish has been blessed with many wonderful people, and Mary was certainly

one of them. Her kindness, support, hard work, and faithful prayers touched countless lives. She will be deeply missed by all who knew her. We give thanks to God for the gift of her life and for the witness of faith and love she shared with our community. May the Lord reward her goodness and welcome her into His eternal kingdom. Rest in peace, Mary. You will be remembered with love and gratitude always. May our loving and merciful God receive you into everlasting life. Amen. (written by Father Carlos)
