From Father Michael:

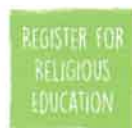
In ancient Israel, the “master of the palace” and Who is the most important assistant to the King? Who is similar to a Prime Minister, He could rule the country in the King’s absence. Because he had the keys to the powers, he had the authority and ability to open and close doors that gave access to the king (Isaiah 22:22). He also had the role of a “father” to the people of Jerusalem, protecting and guiding and leading them in the name of the King.

In today’s Gospel, Jesus gives Peter the Keys to the Kingdom of heaven, and makes him the “rock” upon which he would build his Church (Matthew 16:19,18). Jesus is making Peter the master of the palace in the Kingdom of God? As holder are the keys to the Kingdom, Peter would have the authority to bind and loose -- to open and close. As head of the Apostles, he would also be, like Eliakim., a father to the Church --- its firm foundation, leader, and guide.

That’s why we often call the successor the pope, the “Holy Father”! He is called to reflect God’s own fatherly care for us, his children.
