FROM KAREN ROWE

Today's Gospel is all about forgiveness. In our current time, we see that in our world, nations have been holding on to grudges for centuries. That is not the message of Jesus' parable. Jesus illustrates his position of forgiveness. We can't hold on to hating and a desire for revenge. We have to let it go.

In the parable, the king was very merciful. The servant owed his king a tremendous amount of money. (today's equivalent would be over \$3 billion) The expectation would have been to have him sold into slavery . Instead, the king writes off the entire debt. He in turn does not forgive a much lesser about and was not generous toward the other servant. Refusing to forgive is a form of anger. Many times it is our pride that gets in the way. When we forgive, we also heal ourselves.

Today's parable is about forgiveness, but there is another important element to it and that is we must not forget how generous God has been to us. He is all merciful and full of love. As we continue to reflect on this message, put God first and know that you are worthy of His love and mercy.
