Testimonial on Care for Creation.

When our parish began exploring solar energy for the rectory, Father asked us to share our experience since we installed solar panels on our home about a year ago.

For our family, the decision to go solar was rooted in our faith. We believe that God calls us to be good stewards of the resources He has entrusted to us. In the Parable of the Talents (Matthew 25:14-30), Jesus teaches us to use our gifts and resources wisely rather than wastefully. Solar energy is one way we can be responsible stewards of the financial resources God has provided. We were also inspired by God's call to care for His creation. Genesis 2:15 tells us that the Lord placed mankind in the garden "to work it and take care of it." By producing clean energy from the sun, we can reduce our dependence on fossil fuels and lessen our environmental impact. While no single family can solve all environmental challenges, we believe each of us has a responsibility to do our part. Since installing solar, we have seen significant reductions in our electric bills, which allows us to direct more of our resources toward our family, our parish, and other charitable causes. Proverbs 21:20 reminds us that "the wise store up choice food and olive oil, but fools gulp theirs down." We view solar as a long-term investment that helps us use our resources prudently and efficiently. Perhaps most importantly, solar panels remind us daily of God's provision. Every sunrise is a reminder of the Creator who sustains us. The same sun that warms the earth and gives life to creation now helps power our home.

We have been very pleased with our decision to install solar and would encourage others to prayerfully consider whether it may be a good option for their family, parish, or organization. We believe it is a practical way to live out our Christian calling to be faithful stewards of both God's creation and the resources He has entrusted to us.
