The prophet Isaiah gives us a beautiful vision: "They shall beat their swords into plowshares and their spears into pruning hooks" (Isaiah 2:4). God calls us to transform what destroys life into something that gives life.

Caring for creation is not simply an environmental issue; it is an act of Christian stewardship. As part of this commitment, Saint Mildred will soon install solar panels in the parish office. This project will help us reduce our environmental impact while also saving money on energy costs, allowing us to be better stewards of the resources entrusted to our parish.

We are grateful to the Diocese of Lexington for supporting this initiative through a loan and to the Franciscan community for a generous grant that helped make this project possible.
