After Jesus feeds the crowd, he sends the disciples off without Him and dismisses the multitude. He quietly prays and when He is ready to join the disciples, He sees that they are in the middle of the sea in a storm. He walks on water to reach them! The act of Jesus walking on water signifies His sovereignty over creation. It portrays Him as divine and capable of enabling His followers to do the seemingly impossible through faith.

Peter's experience reveals the struggle between faith and doubt, suggesting that moments of uncertainty are part of the Christian journey. Jesus's response to Peter serves as a symbolic gesture reminding us that help is always available, and we can turn to Him in our moments of fear. It highlights the need for faith in our relationship with Christ—faith that not only acknowledges His power but depends on it in times of distress.

Furthermore, the worship of the disciples at the end signifies an understanding of the true identity of Jesus as the Son of God. Such revelations are foundational in developing a relationship with Him and understanding the principles of faith, obedience, and trust. Jesus responds to our cries for help, instructing us that resilience in faith often emerges through the trials we face. Our struggles are not without purpose and that every trial can lead to a deeper understanding of God.

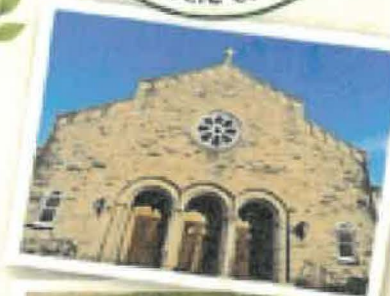
