FROM BILLY SIMS

In this Sunday's Gospel (Matthew 20:1-16), the landowner pays the exact same wage to those who labored all day and those who worked only a single hour. To our modern minds, this feels completely unfair. We live in a culture obsessed with performance awards, instantaneous results, and keeping score. We naturally assume that our rewards should completely reflect our efforts. Yet, God operates on divine mercy rather than human reasoning. The parable challenges us to examine how we view both our own spiritual standing and the grace given to others. Do we harbor secret resentment when someone experiences a profound conversion late in life, or when God's forgiveness reaches and saves someone we deem "unworthy" because of their life choices before that turning point?

In our daily lives, this Gospel reading invites us to lose the scorecard. Whether we have walked with Christ since childhood (cradle Catholics) or are returning to the Church and the Sacraments after a long absence, the invitation into the vineyard (Heaven) is a free gift. Instead of envying the grace shown to others, let us rejoice in God whose generosity greatly exceeds our expectations. When people late in their lives finally accept Christ and desire the love of Jesus and His saving grace in their lives, we should celebrate, as that person will receive the reward of eternal life just like those who have lived their strong faith all of their lives. Change in schedule: There will only be Friday confessions on the first Friday of the month. As always, you can contact the priest to make an appointment to hear your confession.

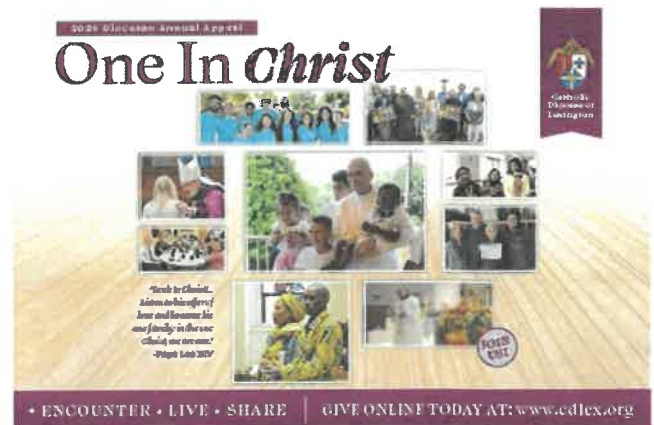
